

In-Vehicle Coaching

90 Minute Coaching Drive



This coaching assessment is designed for:

- Drivers who have been evaluated as partially or not competent following a 60-minute in-vehicle evaluation, display unsafe behaviours or have recorded complaints or incidents against them.
- Drivers who are unfamiliar with New Zealand roads, rules and regulations
- Drivers with new or additional responsibilities to their driving work requirements
- Drivers in need of a refresher due to a near miss or outdated knowledge

These are drivers who have been identified by an organisation as partially or not competent. This may be determined by organisational Health & Safety Policy, incident statistics and or information gathered by the company through company procedures, their insurer or online interventions measuring crash risk. This 90 minute coaching and evaluations drive is undertaken using the drivers usual vehicle.

A full report is provided on all aspects of the drivers style. Skill level, knowledge and behaviour relating to the driving task, focusing on known weaknesses due to organisational incident/crash/infringements/selfperpetuating attitudes. This is also an excellent intervention for drivers who wish to reduce overall crash risk through latest information, sound decision making, speed choices and knowledge of fatigue probabilities, optimisation of safety margins including journey planning and fuel efficiencies in relation to safety.

This is not a driving test, it is aimed to assist a driver to increase awareness and reduce the risk of incident in their work driving duties.

What's involved

- 90 minute in vehicle practical session.
- A one-on-one session with a trained driving instructor to increase awareness.
- Takes place from your work location.
- One person per course with their own personal vehicle.

What will you get out of the programme?

- A risk assessment report and any areas of weakness.
- A report including feedback and on areas of risk and how to reduce them.
- Increased awareness of correct driving practices.
- Assists you to meet workplace safety regulations including director's duty of care.
- Engages staff in the vehicle H&S process.

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
