

TRAILER TOWING TRAINING INFORMATION

Account Manager to obtain this detail from customer prior to setting up training

Fleet Driver Training

Required prior to Training for each site

Type of vehicle and trailer that client will supply

- Also requires type of towbar: older 1 7/8 inch or newer 50mm diameter.
- Type of trailer brake: Service brake, parking brake or breakaway brake.

Training Content

In conjunction with the Familiarisation sheet

- A group briefing and question session around the "situated" vehicle and trailer, plus the 'TWIRL' of the client supplied Vehicle and trailer, for up to 8 drivers at once. This will take 45 minutes.
- Next, each of the 8 drivers will have been scheduled individually and consecutively, for a 45-minute low speed trailer reversing, uncoupling of trailer and practical drive session. All details are covered in the tick box familiarisation sheet.
- Each driver needs to report at the allocated time for their practical driving appointment and have their current and valid NZ driver's license with them for sighting by the Trainer. (Against the list of names provided).
- Ideally, an 8.30 am prompt start, (or earlier if suitable for both the company and trainer) for the group briefing, then each driver to be available, as scheduled, for their individual 45-minute driving component, throughout the day.
- Trainer to be scheduled for a minimum of 45 minutes for lunch break.
- Each driver ideally completes the tick boxes on the familiarisation sheet as each subject of training is covered and makes notes as appropriate.
- These 8 drivers will be comprehensively trained on the day. (Group session and Individual drive).
- There will be plenty of time for questions throughout the training.
- Appropriate safety work gear is required to be worn.
- Adherence to all workplace Health and Safety requirements to be observed.
