

4WD Varied Terrain Course



This one day course will enable an employee to drive a 4WD effectively and safely over varied terrain, as may be required in an off-road workplace.

Driver awareness levels, responses to failures, emergency situations and fuel efficiency are looked at and discussed. This provides a clear path towards safe, efficient, low risk driving practices in a 4WD environment.

Who is the course for?

The course is specifically designed for employees that drive a 4WD vehicle for work and those who, from time-to-time, may be required to drive in varied terrain as part of their work task.

Training Day Details

- Up to 12 people can participate per course with a minimum of 6 required.
- Timing – One full day (plus any travel).
- Location – The course is designed, and will take place, in a designated off road environment to simulate your work driving situations.

What's involved

A full day of 4WD theory and practical training including:

- An interactive classroom-based group discussion session that increases awareness of off-road environments.
- A practical in-vehicle off-road training exercise to demonstrate the concepts required to meet the programme objective.

What will you get out of the programme?

- A certificate of completion for each driver.
- Feedback and coaching on areas of risk and how to reduce them.
- Increased awareness of 4WD practices and how to manage risks of driving off-road.
- Assists you to meet new workplace safety regulations including directors duty of care.
