It's also a great conversation starter and education tool to share with your team.



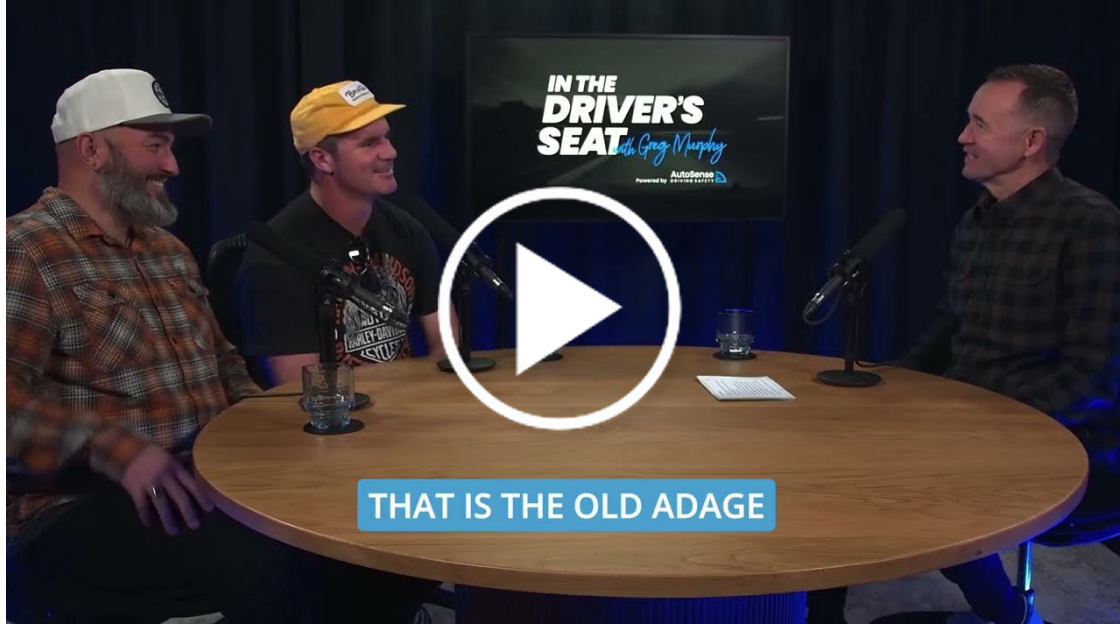
In the Driver's Seat with Greg Murphy
